
**Electronic Journals**

Customers frequently ask library staff what electronic journals are available to them. The Library currently has access to over 1,300 titles. To access and find out what titles are available, search the Journals Database via the Library website:



Click on **Journals** from the menu on the left hand side of the screen and select **Search print and electronic journals**. Type in the title of the journal in the search box and click **Search** or browse for titles using the alphabetical links below the search box.


If a journal is available full text, a link will be available above the journal title. You will need an Athens username and password to access the full text, please contact the Library for more details. The database also gives information about print titles held in the Library.

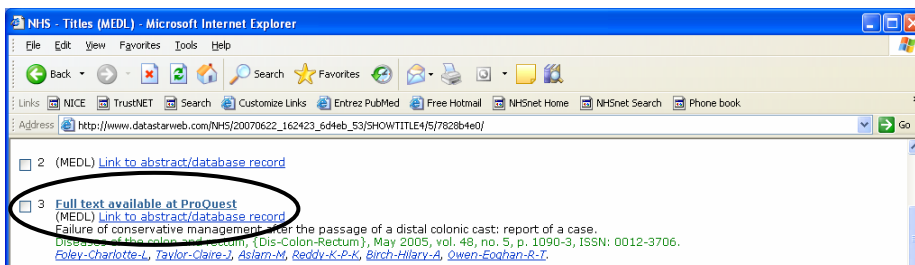

<b>Aim</b>	Learn to search for journal article abstracts or citations using quality health databases, including Medline, BNI, CINAHL, PsycINFO & DH-Data. Learn to access over 1,000 full-text journals.
